IOSH Managing Safely – Managing Safely is an accredited health and safety qualification designed to give Managers and Supervisors the key skills and knowledge required to ensure they are up to date with the latest health & safety legislation allowing them to manage health and safety effectively.

Manual Handling – Across all industries correct lifting is something that needs to be taken seriously. More than a third of all over-three-day injuries reported each year to HSE and local authorities are caused by incorrect manual handling. Our half day Manual Handling course complies with HSE requirements for safe manual handling and will greatly reduce the risk of accident and injury to you and your colleagues.

PASMA – Working at Heights Regulations require that only competent people are permitted to work at height and manage work at height activities PASMA is the most widely recognised form of Prefabricated Mobile Access Tower Training in the UK. The course covers working safely with mobile access towers up to a height of 4 metres. Successful delegates will receive a competency certificate and Photo ID verifying that they have passed the written and practical tests of PASMA's strictly enforced standards.

PASMA – Low Level Access -The PASMA Low level access course covers working safely at heights of up to 2.5 metres (step ladders, podiums etc). It is imperative that anybody working at height is given the correct training to minimise the costly risk of accident or injury through falls. Successful delegates will receive a competency certificate and Photo ID verifying that they have passed the written and practical tests of PASMA's strictly enforced standards.

Asbestos Awareness - Stated in the Control of Asbestos Regulations 2006, it is mandatory for anyone to receive training who is involved in disturbing the fabric of a building. This includes maintenance workers and others who may come into contact with or who may disturb asbestos as well as those involved in asbestos removal work. Our half day Asbestos Awareness course complies with HSE requirements for working safely with asbestos. There are significant health and financial risks associated with the failure to ensure sufficient training is given for those that may encounter asbestos when working.
